

FITNESS TO PRACTISE GUIDANCE – IMPORTANT

When completing the Fitness to Practise section of the application form, it is important candidates answer all questions truthfully and accurately. Failure to do so is considered a probity issue and may cause the candidate to be referred to their regulatory body.

Completion and submission of *Fitness to practise declaration form*

Any candidate who answers 'yes' to one or more of the questions in the Fitness to Practise section of the application form, must complete the London and South East (LaSE) Recruitment Office Fitness to Practise (FTP) declaration form providing further details regarding their affirmative/positive answer.

Failure to complete all sections of the FTP Declaration form and submit the form by the closing date of applications will result in the withdrawal of the candidate's application.

Where fitness to practise issues arise after an application has been submitted, candidates must contact the LaSE Recruitment Office via <https://lasepgmdesupport.hee.nhs.uk/support/home> within three calendar days of the fitness to practise issue arising to make a full declaration.

Any change in a candidate's fitness to practise status should also be declared to the LaSE Recruitment Office within three calendar days.
